

By 1990, San Luis Obispo thrash act, **INTRINSIC**, had two releases under its belt (1987's *Intrinsic* LP and 1990's *Distortion Of Perspective EP*). But while recording what would become their sophomore album, Nails, the direction of the music industry was shifting. The industry had a "sound" they were wanting and if it did not replicate **METALLICA's** Black Album, **PANTERA** or **HELMET** most bands where pretty much out of luck. Having self-financed their new progressive thrash opus **INTRINSIC** quickly found themselves out of step with the industry. So the Nails sessions where shelved for nearly 25 years, until now.

In 2014 **INTRINSIC** reached out to Divebomb Records and after hearing a single preview, it quickly struck up a deal that would finally bring Nails to the masses, however before the contract ink was even able to dry a colossal roadblock had presented itself. The band's sole master recording DAT had degraded since its last use and it was deemed unusable. Could this be the end, before it was able to start? By a stroke of luck, the original engineer had preserved the session reels and it was determined that a brand new mix could be created from scratch. Not being able to predict these new expenses the band turned to their longtime fans to help raise money via crowdfunding and the fans came through! The goal of the campaign was achieved in just three days and Nails was given new life.

Divebomb Records is excited to present Nails in this special edition reissue. The 20-page booklet contains band supplied archival photos/flyers and features full lyrics with brand new essay detailing the making of the album. This is a reissue for the fans, by the fans.

More than most outside the city would have realized in the early '90s, Seattle's music scene was all over the place, as this delightfully brash and fun debut album shows. Like a more punk-edged Cheap Trick, **FLOP** takes pop hooks and loud riffs to the masses with good humor and energetic playing. With production mostly by Young Fresh Fellows/Fastbacks guru Kurt Bloch, who obviously knew a good time when he saw it, *Mopsqueezer* skips from one highlight to the next, including **THE KINKS**' "Big Sky". There's as much metal riffing as melody at play on *Mopsqueezer*, it's just that the latter always keeps the former in check.

Returning fully to Frontier Records after Whenever You're Ready was deemed a commercial failure by Sony, FLOP wrapped up its short but sweet existence with one more great record. World of Today stints neither on the hooks nor the blasting power, and with Kurt Bloch again doing the production, all is more than well. If Willoughby sounds a touch brusquer at points than before, especially in comparison to Whenever You're Ready, it's in the service of engagingly pumping it up and blowing down the door. Though FLOP really never changed from start to end in terms of what it did, it did it well, and more often than not Willoughby's sly lyrics pack in a lot in a short amount of space. "Waste of Space" is a good example from World of Today, capturing a situation of emotional frustration smartly: "Complain in a word or two but never action/Wasted is the useless space I occupy/Worried that my heart will never be satisfied." As before, pop smarts also covers accomplished musicianship; more than once the quartet creates a rock-out din that could easily match any of the big Seattle names of the early '90s. Perhaps Willoughby just needed to sing gruffly instead of sunnily about his pain... Subtlety in the music is never far away either - the acoustic breakdown and distanced vocal echo in the middle of "April Ate Our World" or the prominent, lovely surfy twang in "Around." The group also makes a neat nod to the past via a rollicking cover of THE MOVE's "Yellow Rainbow." With this as an epitaph, FLOP shows it deserved far more attention than most of the other less-deserving bands that did.

LILYS' etheric second full-length album, Eccsame The Photon Band, has become a Shoegaze collector's favorite. Out of print for twenty years, the highly sought, rare first edition vinyl is nearly impossible to come by. This 21st anniversary re-release includes original artwork and has an enhanced dynamic range with the reordering of songs. "The Hermit Crab" has been moved and now begins side two, allowing for a deeper cut of side one and therefore increased audio fidelity, creating a more exciting listening experience than previously available.

Eccsame The Photon Band has been described as "one of the LILYS' best", "a hallucinatory revelation" and "a masterpiece of mood, atmosphere and production".

Producer Rich Costey, who helped create the album's iconic textures said: "it's a combination of several things: the hard, open space that was the live room and also the minimal and incredibly powerful, tasteful playing of Harry Evans. Listening to it today, it seems a study in how a drummer should play to the sound presented to him or her, as opposed to the other way around."

What we have here is pretty incredible; this is a lost record from 1985. We didn't find the tapes, or the reels, we found *the actual records!!!* While working on *The Great Rock N Raoul Swindle* compilation tape, the Datchord label decided it was probably a good idea to make a "real record" if they wanted people to take them seriously. They got their good friends **FOD** and **THE DEAD MILKMEN** to record tracks for a split 7". Meanwhile, behind the scenes, the guys from Datchord had talked a young friend into financing the record on his parent's credit card, unbeknownst to them. Unfortunately the shipment of records and the invoice showed up at his parents' house while the young man was at school. The parents told him they sent the records back to the pressing plant but here– 30 years later– that young man came home to help his folks move into an assisted living home only to find the original records, the plates and the original xeroxed artwork in the back of their basement!!! He turned the components over to the bands and at long last, this split 7" 45 will see the light of day: we got the covers, assembled the records and they are finally ready for your listening enjoyment!

The **FLAG OF DEMOCRACY**'s fast, snotty hardcore fits perfectly in between its classic *Love Songs* EP and the *Shatter Your Day* LP. **THE DEAD MILKMEN** track is like a missing piece from *Big Lizard in My Backyard...* because it is! Recorded at the beginning of those sessions and mixed in a hurry to have it in time for this split, this song is perfect early **MILKMEN**, and it's never been heard before now!
